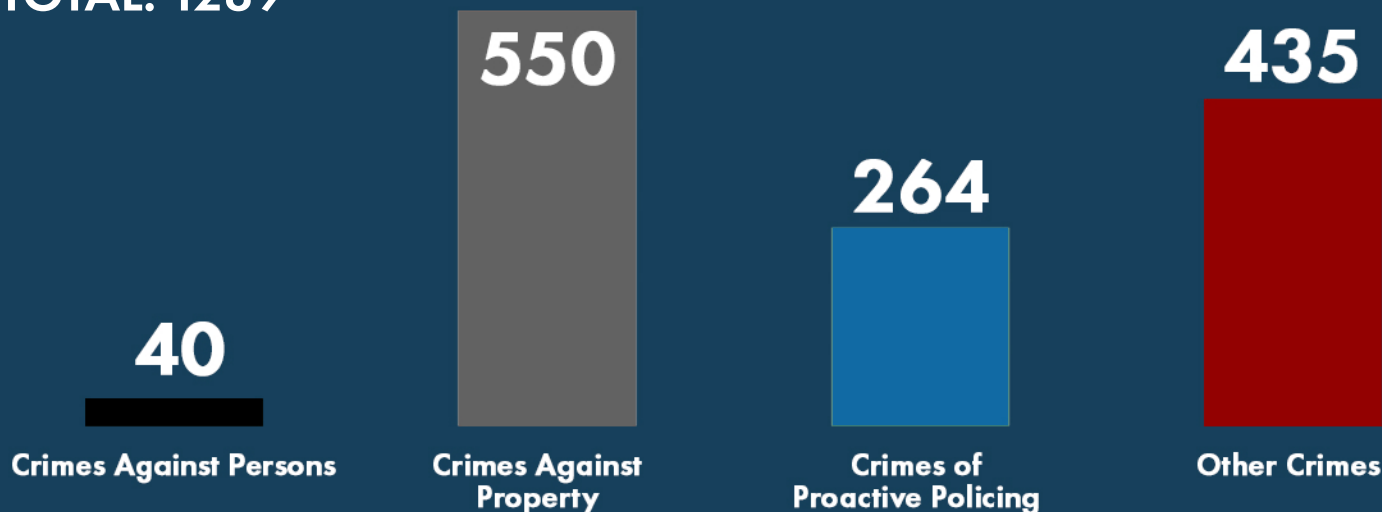

WARRANTS SERVED

This section includes the work of several divisions within the Jonesboro Police Department. The Uniform Patrol Division is responsible for most of the Calls for Service dispatched by the E-911 Center. JPD took 5956 calls for service during December 2019, up from 5841 in November 2019, and up from 5318 in December 2018. As a whole, JPD filed 1027 incident reports in December 2019, bringing the total for the year to 12378. A total of 458 Warrants were served by JPD during December 2019 across several divisions including Uniform Patrol, Street Crimes, Warrants, CID, DTF, and more.

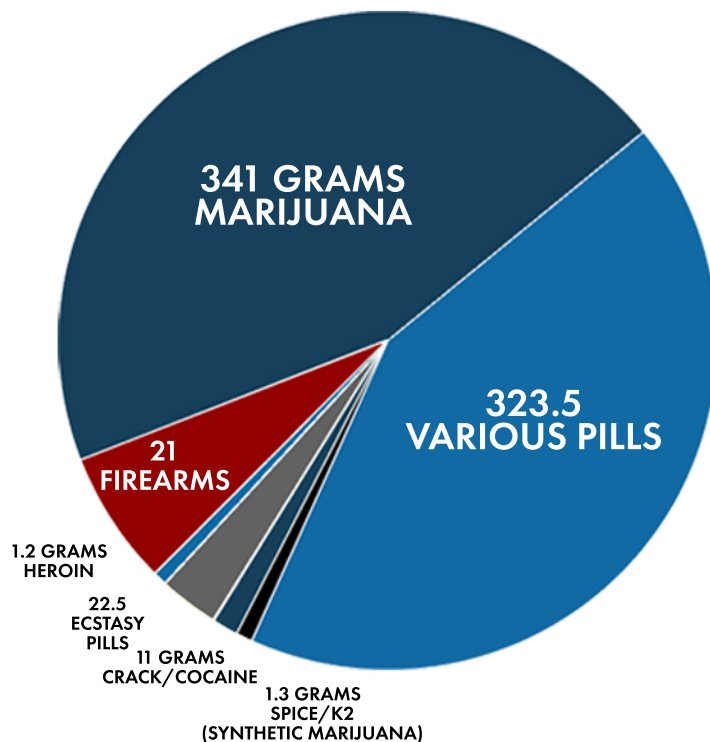

STREET CRIMES UNIT

The Street Crimes Unit specializes in criminal patrol, narcotics enforcement, gang investigation, and prostitution activity. The unit conducts directed patrols, investigates citizen complaints of street-level criminal activity, and directly assists the 2nd Judicial Drug Task Force. The Street Crimes Unit also assists any division within the Jonesboro Police Department whenever needed.

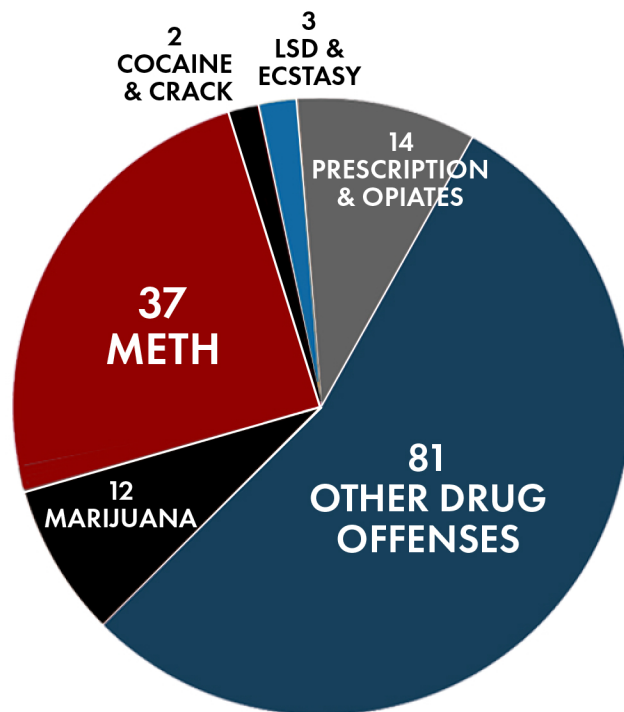

DRUG TASK FORCE

The Second Judicial Drug Task Force was established through a cooperative effort of the Second Judicial Prosecutor and District law enforcement agencies to combat narcotics and organized crime. They investigate major drug traffickers in our area, including all types of illegal drugs. They work closely with local, state, and federal agencies to eradicate drugs from our community. Currently there are eight Jonesboro Police Officers assigned to the Task Force.

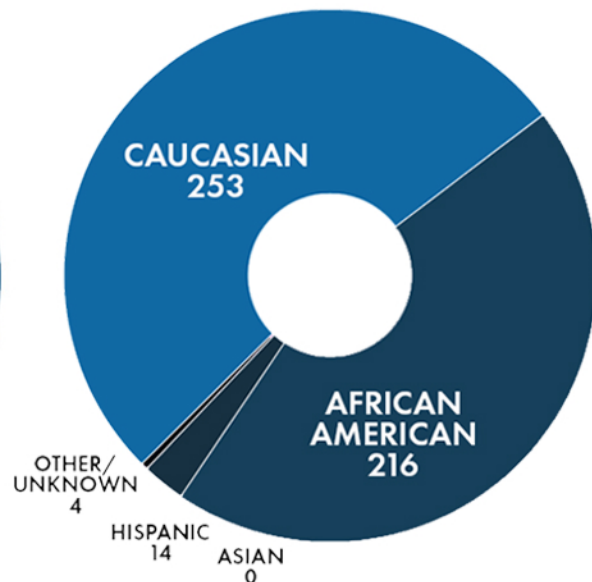
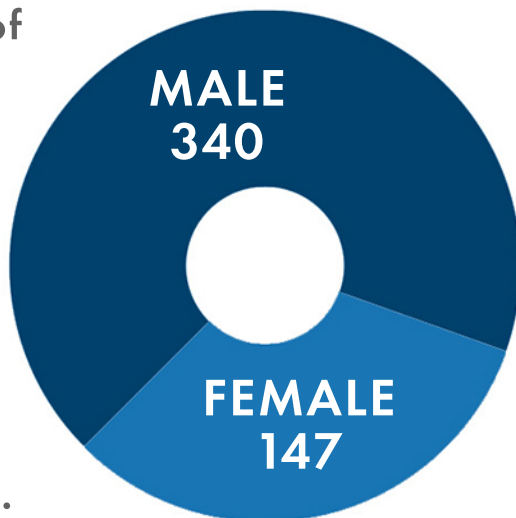


JONESBORO POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

In December 2019, there were a total of 487 arrests carried out by the Jonesboro Police Department. This number is up from 445 arrests during December 2018 and up from 421 arrests during November 2019. Arrests were made by all divisions of the department, including Patrol, Traffic, Street Crimes Unit, Drug Task Force, CID, and others. This section breaks down these arrests by gender and race.
